AN ORDINANCE

License and Regulating the Manufacture and Sale of Spirituous, Vinous and Fermented Liquors.

SEC. 1.—Be it ordained by the City Council of this City, that no person or persons, shall, in this City, directly or indirectly, manufacture, sell, or otherwise dispose of, for or on his or their account, any spirituous, vinous or fermented liquor, without a license first obtained, according to the provisions of this Ordinance, as a dram-shop keeper, liquor dealer, wine dealer, or otherwise.

SEC. 2.—A dram-shop keeper is a person permitted by law, being licensed according to the provisions of this Ordinance, to sell spirituous, vinous and fermented liquors, or either, to be drunk at the place of sale.

SEC. 3.—A wine dealer is a person permitted by law, being licensed according to the provisions of this Ordinance, to sell spirituous, vinous and fermented liquors, or either, to be drunk at the place of sale.
