WASHINGTON, 6.—The committee examining the condition of the United States Treasury are making rapid progress. The bonds held to secure circulation of national banks, the bonds held as security for public deposits, and the bonds of the Indian trust funds have been counted and found to agree with the amount called for. All odds and ends have been closed up, and the work now before the committee is a straight count of the sealed packages of reserve United States notes and bags of silver coin. There are 1,350 packages of notes, each package containing 4,000 notes. There are about 2,500 bags of silver, each bag containing \$1,000. The count will not be finished for two weeks, but the members of the committee say "the treasury is in good shape in every respect."

The Commissioner of the General Land Office sent to the Surveyor General of Mexico to-day a patent for the private land claim known as the "Artochico grant." The land is situated in San Miguel and Bernalillo Counties, New Mexico, and contains 378,573 acres.

It is estimated by persons thoroughly familiar with the subject that under the new law reducing the letter postage and regulating the pay of postmasters the receipts of not more than one office in every four, on the general average, will be in excess of the postmaster's salary. Under existing laws, it is said, all the postoffices, however insignificant, contributed about two-fifths of their receipts to the Government.

The Secretary of State transmitted to the Treasury Department a report from R. M. Daggett, Minister Resident at Honolulu, with regard to the statement recently made to the effect that Chinese sugars are being imported at Honolulu, thence to be shipped to the United States which would pay no duty. Mr. Daggett says that a thorough investigation he is satisfied that the statements above referred to are entirely without foundation.

The examination of John Dorsey was continued. He was asked who he had written his brother that he regarded the Tongue River route as worth \$100,000 for the term. He answered that the statement was his ignorance of the business of running mail routes.

The Catalogue of Crime.

CHARLESTON, Mo., 6.—Howard Underwood, white, was hanged here to-day. He passed a quiet night and the morning dressed in a suit of white prepared for his last journey. He was accompanied by a Baptist minister. The prisoner addressed the crowd of 5,000. He said, "My brothers and sisters, I am standing on the brink of eternity. I am happy. I am at rest with Jesus. I am going with golden slippers and white robes to walk up and down the streets of glory. I am in Jesus and I love him. I want you all to love one another, to be honest and live right. He sang 'Precious Name,' and showed no signs of faltering. The crowd sang 'Nearer My God to Thee.' He died in seven minutes, and the body was cut down. Underwood killed a woman named Bell, a colored girl, by shooting her and beating her head to pieces, more than a year ago.

Vicksburg, Miss., 6.—Alexander Williams, colored, was arrested for, outraging a negro girl, Lena Moses, living on Deer Creek. He was taken out of jail last night and hanged by a mob.

New York, 6.—The trial of Geo. W. Conkling, Jr., indicted for manslaughter, in killing Wm. H. Haverstick, has been adjourned till the 30th inst.

Boston, 6.—A warrant is issued for the arrest of Carleton, who, according to John Clark (alias), induced a black named Condit to murder William H. Condit, a colored man, and negro \$250. It is now believed Condit and Clark also murdered old man Whittemore some months ago.

The police now believe Carleton innocent, and consider Clark's confession a conspiracy to obtain the money of the Court and other persons, constantly in store and made to order.

Boston, 6.—The second trial of James S. Lyon, ended in the verdict of guilty. He was charged with embezzlement, being accessory to the big steal of Jas. B. Bort, a city treasurer, also convicted and awaiting sentence.

Ottawa, 6.—On Wednesday afternoon while Sergeant Hughes and police officers were in the hallway of the basement of the eastern department building, a bottle containing some explosive was thrown from above and burst with tremendous force. The explosion blew the bottle containing and succeeded in getting shelter behind a pillar before it exploded. The case was a secret till to-night. It is in the hands of the Dominion police.

Death and Disaster.

NIAGARA FALLS, 6.—The heavy rain the past 80 hours caused a flood here, and Bridge Street is covered with water to the depth of two feet. Several thousand dollars damage is done to goods in cellars and stores. Fifty feet of the Canada Southern track is washed away, and trains will not be able to run to Niagara till to-morrow.

Little Rock, 6.—There was a severe wind, rain and hail storm on Thursday night, doing considerable damage to buildings and fences and blowing down many trees. Along the line of the Hot Springs & Malvern Railway the cyclone developed such force that the wind lifted a passenger coach from the track and sent it down an embankment. Several persons were injured, none seriously.

At Mabelville, ten miles south of Little Rock, a dozen residences and many stables were blown down. The railroads in the neighborhood are so covered with fallen timber as to be impassable. No lives lost.

Denver, 6.—A freight train on the Atchafalaya, between Santa Fe and near La Junta, Col., early this morning, broke the couplings, the tender striking the bulk-head of the locomotive boiler with great force,

causing the steam to escape. Jas. Horner, fireman, jumped from the engine, and was instantly killed. Blumer Dickson, brakeman, died this evening, being badly scalded. Jas. Willard, engineer, is also scalded, but will probably recover. The relatives of both deceased live in Texas and Tennessee.

Shelbyville, Tenn., 6.—A fire early this morning destroyed five business houses and contents. Loss \$100,000; insured \$40,000.

New Orleans, 6.—The river is one inch higher than last year, causing apprehensions for the safety of the levees. Raining to-night.

Vicksburg, 6.—This section was visited to-day by the heaviest rain for years. Four and one-quarter inches fell. Many bridges are washed away.

New York, 6.—Associations and corporations continue to adopt resolutions of regret at the death of Peter Cooper. The Western Union Company expresses its earnest appreciation of the death of this eminent man in the development of telegraphic enterprise in the days of its infancy.

Topeka, Kas., 6.—Information from the towns of Empire City and Galena, which are only separated by an imaginary line, is to the effect that there is no abatement in the small-pox here. Business of both towns entirely suspended. The local authorities have exhausted all the funds at their command. Citizens alone there have been 10 deaths. The population is mostly of people of slender means.

Fort Custer, Montana, 6.—The death is announced of Lieut. Jno. H. Coates, Second Cavalry, yesterday, after a long illness.
