QUESTIONS WILL BE ASKED AGAIN

Mr. Harriman May Answer Them
In Federal Court Next
October.

THE QUERIES WHICH FAILED.

Would Tell Nothing of Chicago & Alton Deal or Purchase of Union Pacific Stocks.

Special Correspondence.

New York, Aug. 19.—The order filed by Atty. Gen. Bonaparte to show cause why E. H. Harriman and Otto H. Kahn should not be brought into court and made to answer questions put to them and unanswered by them during the recent interstate commerce hearing, has created a sensation in local financial and railroad circles. Report has reached this city that Mr. Harriman has now decided to answer the commission's questions as are not aimed at his personal affairs. Whether he has or has not will develop in the federal court, October 21, the date selected by the order filed on which to re-ask certain questions met with refusal to answer by Mr. Harriman and Kahn before.

THE QUESTIONS.

Most of the questions that Mr. Harriman refuses to answer had to do with the financing of the Chicago & Alton deal, and the purchase of various stocks from the Union Pacific company. One of the chief queries that the witness balked at was:

Q.—"How much of the Chicago & Alton stock, sold at 80¢ to the Northern Pacific, did you yourself own?"

A.—"I refuse to answer."

Another question referred to the sale of \$2,242,440 St. Joe & Grand Island stock, which Mr. Harriman admitted having turned over to the Union Pacific since July 1, 1906.

Q.—"Where did you acquire those stocks?"

A.—"I refuse to answer."

The chairman: "Is there any objection to his stating the time when he purchased them?"

Mr. Milburn: "Yes, it is all on the same line."

Q.—"What did you pay for those stocks?"

A.—"I decline to answer on the same ground."

Q.—"Were any of the directors of the Union Pacific interested directly or indirectly in the New York Central stocks at the time they were sold?"

A.—"I decline to answer."

Q.—"I mean at the time the Union Pacific bought these shares of the New York Central stock, were any of the directors interested in the sale of those particular shares?"

A.—"I decline to answer."

Mr. Harriman also refused to say whether or not he owned any of the Chicago & Alton preferred stock, which was deposited with Kuhn, Loeb & Co., and subsequently sold to the Union Pacific. The witness' contention was that that was a private matter and did not concern interstate commerce.

Mr. Kahn based his refusal to answer questions put to him on his right to keep private the affairs of his firm's individual clients.
