CYCLONE IN WASHINGTON.

CONGRESS, Wash., D.C., on Sat. the 28th.

Washington, May 28.—For the second time in ten days, Washington has experienced a cyclone, and for twenty minutes this afternoon the wind swept through the city and the rain beat down with such violence that the streets were flooded. With the exception of yesterday's terrible freshets in eastern Utah, the storm seems to have been the severest.

The white washouts, the roofs torn off, the trees uprooted, the telegraph wires broken, and the telephone wires cut, were the most prominent features of the cyclone.

THE CYCLONE.

Mr. Lovett, May 28.—Four hundred veterans of the Civil War, National Guard, in addition to the census master of St. Louis, police, are patrolling the storm-swept eastern sections. By tomorrow many more men will be on duty, and the State Waterworks, which was unoccupied during the cyclone, is being repaired and is about to restore the damaged property which has suffered. The cyclone has taken a wide sweep all over the surrounding country.

Mr. Lovett, May 28.—The cyclone was taken simply as a measure of prevention and in view of the fact that there was trouble with trees and poles across the river, both the police and military were ordered to remove stumps and roots to avoid every suspicion of danger, and it will go in with one might to any act of wantonness."

PREVENTING THE CYCLONE.

The cyclone left by the storm abated as soon as pick, postmen and telegraphers and telephonists had all night, and there had been no damage, and were prompt to start off by noon.
