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A Full Pardon for Joyce.

WASHINGTON, 19.—The President, to-day, signed a pardon for John A. Joyce, convicted of conspiracy to defraud the United States of taxes on distilled spirits. The pardon is full and unconditional. Joyce, it will be remembered, was sentenced to \$2,000 fine in addition to his imprisonment.

A Loosely Drawn Constitution.

Legal experts claim that Georgia's recently adopted constitution was so loosely drawn that it leaves the State without a governor. It reduces its number of congressmen and falls in the State's purpose of holding the railroad companies in a monetary legislative grip. It does, however, exclude State's creditors from the courts.

The Free Coinage of Silver.

The prospect of passing any bill for the free coinage of silver continues to recede, and there seems to be little doubt that the friends of Bland's bill will abandon it when the Senate's amendments are adopted, because they insist that, without unlimited silver coinage, there is no chance of establishment of an equilibrium between the two metals and no restoration of the double standard. Murat Halstead openly counsels the defeat of any bill which does not give every silver owner the right to have it coined into dollars at will.

Letter to President Hayes on the Chinese Question.

The following letter was sent to President Hayes, today, by the resident U. S. Washington representative of California:

WASHINGTON, 19.—

"In the consideration of any question of public or private concern it is well to have facts for the ground work, and as the Hon. H. F. Page from Fairview, Cal., member of the House of Representatives, has asked your consideration of the question of Chinese immigration, for reasons stated in the enclosed letter of the 10th inst., as published in the New York Herald," permit me to invite your attention to the extraordinary character of the figures furnished for your guidance, and the means so ingeniously supplied for a partial correction. If Mr. Page had read the report preferred for your guidance he must have experienced peculiar emotions in making the assertion that you are, doubtless, aware that there is in the State of California more than 150,000 of these people, about one-fifth of whom are found in the great cities of San Francisco, San Jose, and Sacramento, and the remainder in the rural districts. Without desiring to deprive the timid, virtuous Californians of your sympathy in their danger, I beg to say that the figures furnished for your guidance, and the means so ingeniously supplied for a partial correction.
