

THE HEE INDUSTRY.

Successful Beekeeping—Ready for the Bee.

The bee industry, like the fruit industry, does not prosper the more it is advertised. It is in order to raise good fruit in paying quantities we must settle, cultivate and trim our trees, vines, etc. We must be alert and vigorously attack and destroy the numerous enemies. In like manner, if we would be successful in beekeeping, we must take care of and protect the bees. It is not such a great amount of work that is necessary, but it is the little needed attention at the proper time. In other words, in order to make beekeeping a success, the most necessary thing is good management.

One of the main things to do in beekeeping is to keep the bees as healthy as possible. As the beekeeper has to feed and protect the bees, it is well to remember that the bees are not only the source of honey, but also of wax, propolis, and other products. The bees are very sensitive to diseases, and the beekeeper must be vigilant in their care.

Another troublesome pest in the beekeeping industry is the varroa mite. This mite is a parasite of the bees and can cause great damage if not properly treated. The beekeeper must be able to recognize the signs of infestation and take prompt action to eliminate the mites.

Next, we find the wax of the hive. The wax is the building material of the bees and is essential for the health of the colony. The beekeeper must ensure that the bees have enough wax and that it is of good quality.

In the fall of the year when they begin to store honey, the bees are very busy. The beekeeper must provide them with enough food to last through the winter. This can be done by feeding them sugar syrup or honey.
