BAD WRECK ON SOUTHERN PACIFIC.

Three Italians Killed and Two Seriously Injured—Trainmen Escaped by Jumping.

HEARING BEFORE JUDGE ROLAPP

Youthful Burglar Sent to Prison—November Jury Verdict—Salvation Army Home—News Briefs.

Another disastrous wreck occurred on the Southern Pacific yesterday morning, resulting in the killing of three Italian laborers, and the serious injury of two others.

The wreck occurred about 8:30 yesterday morning near the Pequot hills, a small siding on the Southern Pacific. Chief Clerk Shealy immediately had a wrecking train prepared and took it out to the scene of the accident. When he arrived the wreckage had been partially cleared away and the passenger train was delayed about six hours only.

The wreck was due to a collision between an eastbound passenger train No. 2, and a work train. The work train was moving slowly eastward on the main line, going on to a switch so the passenger could pass, but before the work train was on the switch, the passenger train struck the caboose, loaded with Italian laborers, splintering it to kindling wood, killing the three men and injuring two others. Several laborers saw the train coming up on them, and jumped to save their lives. The engine attached to the work train was pushing several cars ahead of it and pulling the caboose. When the collision came, it knocked the engine loose from the caboose. The engineer and fireman jumped from the engine, which was sent with the cars in front of it nearly a half mile down the track. The engineer and fireman on the passenger train with the two injured men to Ogden. The injured were taken to the Ogden general hospital, where they are being cared for. Their names are Santo Pucile, who is badly cut about head and face, and left arm fractured. Ira Fitts, cut over forehead.

YOUTHFUL BURGLAR.

Judge Rolapp had a youthful burglar before him for sentence in the district court in the person of Frank Cunningham, who was sentenced to one year in the state prison. Cunningham was arrested about a month ago on the charge of burglarizing Mrs. Pullen's store on the corner of Madison avenue and Twenty-first street. Judge Thompson was implicated with him in the crime. The two boys, who are in their teens, were first sent by Judge Rolapp to the Reform school on account of their youth. They terrorized the school. Cunningham was sent back to the court where he pleaded guilty and was sentenced to one year at the state prison. Young Thompson returned to the school and promised to obey the rules, but should he violate them again he will also be sent to prison. Sheriff Bailey took Cunningham and Lorenzo Rockefeller to the penitentiary last evening. The latter will serve a 60 days term for felony.

The taking of testimony for the prosecution in the \$25,000 damage suit brought by Mrs. Jane L. Warner against the Union Pacific was completed yesterday afternoon. Judge Young for the defense moved for a nonsuit, which was argued at length and denied. The defense will put in their testimony during the remainder of the week.
