Precipitation occurred over portions of Utah, Idaho, Nevada, California, Oregon, Washington, Montana, North Dakota, Minnesota, Nebraska, Illinois, Louisiana, Texas, and the British possessions. It was raining this morning at San Francisco, Portland, and Boise, and snowing at Pocatello, Thunderbolt, and reported at Galveston, and at New Orleans.

The temperature changes were unimportant except a fall of 10 degrees or more over portions of Utah, Colorado, Wyoming, Idaho, Montana, and Arizona, and a marked rise over portions of Texas, Oklahoma, Missouri and Manitoba.
