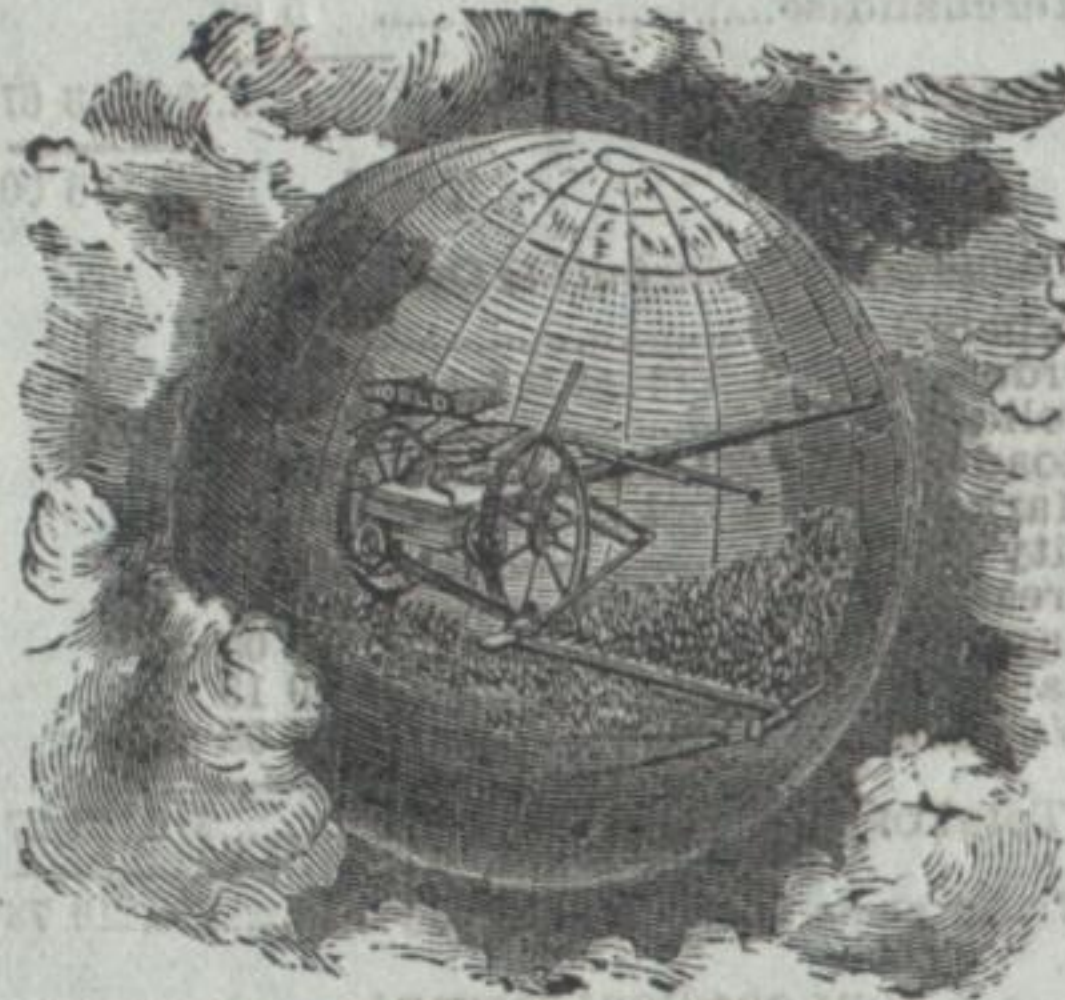

LOCAL AND OTHER MATTERS.

A NEW SWITCH AT WOOD'S CROSS.—President Young and Superintendent Little and Engineer Jessie W. Fox, of the U. C. R. R. accompanied by several gentlemen, surveyed and laid out a new switch at the Wood's Cross Station of the U. C. R. R.

LARGE TRAIN OF CATTLE.—The California papers notice the arrival of twenty-eight car loads of beef cattle, destined for the San Francisco market, from different parts of Nevada and Utah. We hope to hear at no distant day of Utah cattle being carried in large quantities both east and west to supply the markets.

BEAR LAKE VALLEY.—Bishop William Budge writes to Brother A. M. Musser from Paris, Rich county, that affairs there are in a prosperous and encouraging condition; the meetings are excellent and the spirit of improvement increases. Elders Kimball and Duffin are about to erect, forthwith, a large tannery, and a number of frame dwellings are about to be built. Net fishing in the Lake and streams has been prohibited, which prohibition will have the effect to increase the trout immensely.

GOT THE "RING" BAD.—Utah is not the only Territory troubled with a "ring," if the Idaho Democrat is reliable, for according to that paper Idaho is badly troubled with the same disease. It offers a few words of advice to Connor, the new Governor of that Territory, not to be enticed by its members. The people of Utah can sympathize. Connor is a poor name, and augurs ill for Idaho and if her redemption from "ringly" power and influence depend upon the acceptance of the Democrat's advice we fear the case is desperate!

BOUNTIFUL.—Bishop John Stoker, of Bountiful, favored the sanctuary with a short visit this morning, and gave in an excellent report of the people, and matters generally in his diocese. He says the folks are A. 1 in almost everything, and as Latter-day Saints cannot be excelled by any of their contemporaries: they are "diligent in business, fervent in spirit, serving the Lord," yet they are constantly improving, in order to keep up with the times.

A good deal of Spring work has been done, some having finished their plowing and planting. Peace, quietness and good will prevail through the entire settlement.

SCANDINAVIA.—Elder W. W. Cluff, President of the Scandinavian mission, writing on the 27th ult., to Elder Joseph F. Smith, of this city, says, among other things, that he has organized Sunday schools in all the large branches throughout the mission, and that both scholars and teachers are taking great interest in them, and they are proving a source of much good. The mission is prosperous; during the winter quite a number have been added to the church; and many more believers, who have not liked the idea of going down into the water with the temperature 20° or 30° below zero, are ready to be baptized as soon as warm weather sets in. Elder Cluff's health is excellent and he enjoys his labors.

GOOD IRON OF UTAH MANUFACTURE.—S. M. Blair, Esq., and others have for the last year or two been devoting their time and means to experiments in the manufacture of iron at Iron City, Iron County, U. T. It is gratifying to record the fact that success is about crowning their labors. They have now, co-operating with them, a man who has had a long experience in the business.—Mr. David Adams, of Adamsville, Beaver Co., U. T., and he has succeeded in making from the ore a specimen of pig iron, pronounced by judges to be of very excellent quality. We trust that the enterprise of the company at Iron City will reap a rich reward; it is deserving of it, and if good marketable iron can be manufactured there, in large quantities it will be a source of incalculable benefit to the Territory.
