

# FOOTBALL SEASON READY TO BEGIN

Outdoor Practise at the University Ordered for First Clear Day.

## HOPE IS TO BEAT BOULDER.

Some Changes That Will Alter the Style of Play This Year In the West.

In the rains of the autumn permit, there will be football galore at the University campus within the week. Coach Mackie has summoned his warriors to star, and the first work will begin at once. Unlike previous years, there is no opportunity this year to hold practise in the darkness, whether the weather will or will not permit. The gym will stand out for athletic purposes, as well suited out for the most indoor, and Mackie can handle his men inside, that kind of practise is desired.

The condition of this season is practically the same as that last year, and that Mackie would rather do than do anything he would be to pluck the Chicago champion. Last year he tried to do it two weeks before he had selected his team, and there was nothing done. The year before Boulder swept us off our feet before training had more than begun.

Secondary Squad.

It is at last getting a foothold on the new rules will make needless calls and references must be schooled in them before play begins in order to gain the principal changes are as follows:

For example, a referee and a linesman are to be officials.

The length of the game has been shortened by ten minutes.

The two touch lines will be separated by the length of the ball, which may be kept flat on the ground by the center man.

Touchdown must have both feet, both hands on the ball, and the opposing end to the exception of one foot of the line, or, under the ground when the ball is down.

One man may run out three yards half without penalty.

For each call for time a team will be penalized two yards unless the injured player is removed from the game.

No HURDLING.

No suspensions are allowed to have his hands and head of side when he is about to pass the ball.

There must be at least six offensive players on the field when there are ten men on the other players are to be outside the man at the end of the line.

None of the five men will be allowed to leave the line unless he goes to the yard back and another player takes his place in the line. No shifting to evade the rule.

Forward pass will be allowed each change, provided the pass be made by the man who was in the backfield when the ball touches the ground.

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Once the ball is kicked, any player on the ball is kicked, any player on the ball side will be on side as soon as the ball touches the ground. Once the ball touches the ground it cannot be kicked further.

A player preparing to kick a goal after a touchdown will be allowed to adjust the ball in the hands of the holder.

All forms of unnecessary roughness are prohibited and penalties provided.

If a player is disqualified, his team will lose half the distance to its goal line.

TEN YARD RULE.

One yard must gain 10 yards in three downs.
