

views is proceeding between the Powers with regard to the possibility of bringing pressure to bear on the Porte. No definite proposals, however, have been made up to the present time, nor has anything been arranged in regard to naval demonstrations by the fleets of the six Powers.

According to private information from Constantinople, the Sultan has instructed his council to discuss the collective note and submit to him a draft of reply to it. It is thought the reply can hardly be delivered to the Powers before the beginning of August.

A German officer has been appointed aide-de-camp to the Sultan.

LONDON, 17.—A Berlin correspondent writes: Germany is acting in the east in concert with Austria, and any alliance with the Porte would be Austro-Turkish, perhaps Austro-German Turkish, but before the idea of such league could be mooted, the wildest melee must be going on in Europe. Only when everybody's hand is raised against his neighbor could there be any occasion for Germany joining Turkey. That the Sultan in his present desperate position, among other visionary schemes, may indulge in the idea of a German-Russian war, and the German-Turkish league is quite creditable, but there is a long way between the actual state of things and such contingency. The Sultan has asked for some members of the Russian civil service to assist in reforming the Turkish administration, and the request has been granted.

In Ireland the weather has been favorable to crops since Thursday.

It is believed the Pasco colliery explosion was caused by lightning striking the winding gear at the top of the shaft. Seventeen bodies have been recovered. It will probably be some days before all can be recovered.

At Matamoras, the American Government has asked permission of General Hatch to cross into Mexico in pursuit of Victorio and his Indians, but the Mexican Government objects, because of an apprehension that this crossing will degenerate into a system of campaigning, thereby awakening a hostile feeling among the Mexicans.

The French Jesuits have purchased the Palace of Ocha, near Curgos, for 121,000 francs. The Council of State has not yet delivered his opinion upon the question of residence of foreign Jesuits in Spain. Several members of the order have left for the Philippine Islands.

An election riot occurred at Victoria Province, Pernambuco. The military fired on the populace and killed 20 including Baron Escoda. Many were wounded.

The Governor of Bagdad has sent troops against the Arabs who attacked the British steamer *Halifax*, and the guilty parties have been arrested.

The Turkish press states that the Admiralty is negotiating for a large supply of coal and provisions, to fit out a squadron for the Mediterranean.

There is reason to believe the Russian government determined some time since to appropriate a considerable sum of money for the enlargement of its fleet, and it is reasonable to suppose Parker, of the United States, who is backed by a powerful American syndicate, is willing to help the government.

Obidden Pasha, in conversation with Goschen, British ambassador, regarding the state of affairs in Asia Minor, said: "You know what difficulties you have in Ireland and how long it has taken you to overcome them. In Asia Minor, where each province has its distinctive peculiarities, we have 15 Irelands to deal with."
