Overwhelming Democratic Majority.

MILWAUKEE, 5.—The republicans of the fourth district, to-day, nominated Wm. E. Smith for Congress.

Democratic National Convention.

Speech by Gov. Hendricks.

Indianapolis, Ind., 5.—Speaking was held on three stands on the State House grounds and other places outside during the afternoon. At the principal stand Gov. Hendricks presided. He spoke as follows:—

Ladies and Gentlemen—You will be addressed by Gov. Hendricks of Illinois, and Gov. Curtin of Pennsylvania. For myself, I have only to express to the citizens of other States that the present to-day is a day of rejoicing for the people of Indiana. The people of Indiana have decided that as far as it is within their power, they will have a pure government, and will have greater economy in the administration of public affairs. I am very happy in welcoming soldiers from other States, who are here in large numbers, who, as I know, join with the soldiers of Indiana upon this occasion in asserting the doctrine that the war now being over, there shall be a reunion between the people of the north and the people of the south, thus expressing their faith in the permanent union of these States, and the people under the forms of the constitution, and your faith in the purity of the Government and economy of the administration. I welcome you upon this occasion to the capital of Indiana. My fellow citizens, I now have the pleasure of introducing Gov. Palmer of Ills., who led some of the soldiers who are here, in the bloody wars of the war, and who will now address you. (Applause.)

The following were the principal speakers: Gov. Curtin, Gen. Farnsworth, Gen. McCandless, Gen. J. O. Palmer, Gen. John A. McArthur, Gen. Sigel, Gen. L. F. Bragg, Gen. Fitzhugh Warren, Gen. McClelland, and Gov. Parker and Bigler at the principal stands.

The following resolutions were adopted:

Whereas, The soldiers and sailors of the country, irrespective of party, race, or nationality, took equal part in defending that country when threatened, and maintaining the integrity of the American honor; and

Whereas, The issues at stake have been for ever settled by the results of the civil contest, and placed beyond all future controversy; and

Whereas, The republican leaders, with disgraceful impudence and effrontery, and in open defiance of truth, attempt to themselves the credit of suppressing the rebellion, and maintaining the Union, and in open disregard of truth and justice, defy and denounce all soldiers and sailors who now refuse to subscribe to their political opinions; and

Whereas, The leaders of the party in power have endeavored, by bitter partisan appeals, to rekindle the animosities of the war and put the free enjoyment of a glorious peace; therefore

Be it resolved, by the democratic soldiers and sailors of the United States, that they will, in the future, while fully recognizing the gallant achievements of our armies, and grateful to Almighty God for the victory to the Union cause, do hereby in the interest of harmony and fellowship between the States, and in the name of command, and now, as a national blessing, enter an earnest and solemn protest against all attempts to revive the hatreds and prejudices engendered by the civil strife.

Resolved, that now, as during the period when war was in progress, in which the question was finally and irreversibly settled, we pronounce the doctrine of the right of secession a fatal heresy, without foundation or right in our system of Government, of destructive to the Union, and that we are firm in our resolve to preserve the integrity of the national government, as settled by the stern arbitrament of the sword, we will act as soldiers who were engaged in honorable warfare. We recognize the gallantry with which those lately in arms against the United States sought to maintain what we believe to be a just error; and now, when the war has accepted the results of the war and recognized their obligations to the policy of the republican party which permits the unlawful plundering of the south and seeks to perpetuate sectional prejudice in order to continue itself in power.

Resolved, that while we maintain that every citizen of the country, without regard to race or color, should be protected in the full enjoyment of their rights of citizenship, we denounce the efforts of the administration to control the elections of certain States of this Union by the aid of the army as a dangerous innovation upon the rights of the

## PEOPLE'S TERRITORIAL CONVENTION.

HEADQUARTERS, People's Territorial Central Committee, Salt Lake City, Sept. 9, 1876.

To the People of Utah.

The election of Delegates to represent the Territory of Utah in the Forty-Fifth Congress will be held on Tuesday, November 7th next ensuing, and it is most desirable that the candidate chosen as the representative of the people should receive their fullest support and that every person entitled to the elective franchise should exercise it on that day.

To the end that an increase of interest may be awakened in election matters, and that the people may draw out the entire vote of the Territory on this important occasion, it has been determined to hold a People's Territorial Convention, composed of Delegates from the several counties, to convene at the City Hall in Salt Lake City, on Saturday, October 7th, 1876, at 12 m.

The business of this convention will be to nominate a candidate for delegate to Congress, and to inaugurate such measures as will insure increased attention to our elections throughout the Territory. The number of delegates to compose the Territorial Convention has been fixed at seventy-eight, being twice the number of the Councilors and Representatives in the Legislative Assembly, and the allotment of delegates to the several counties has been made as follows:

It is hoped that the leading men in each County will take immediate steps to carry these suggestions into effect, by calling primary meetings in their respective counties, and by appointing a delegate to the Territorial Convention in their County, that the people may be thoroughly aroused to their duty, that the result of these measures may prove beneficial to our citizens, and that the delegate selected to represent the County may receive, at the coming election, such a vote as was never before given to a delegate from any Territory.
