Supposed She Is Restored to Her Throne By This Time.

LEHIGH STRIKE ABOUT OVER.

New Tar Bill.—The U.S. and Their Leases.—Maurice Stevens Lectures.

Washington, D. C., Nov. 22.—The effects of the state department's long delay in naming Queen Lilioukalnia has by this time been restored to the Hawaiian throne, while not fixing the precise time when the restoration took place, and they believe force was unnecessary. It seems, however, that while actual force may not have been authorized, there was to be used a show as to make the provisional government believe that the United States would use all the power at its command to bring about the restoration.

The statement is also made that if the rebels refused to accede to the demands of Willis, he would be turned over to the quasi rulers, even if the administration did not call on Congress for assistance. At the same time it is claimed that there will be no necessity for any such action, as the information from the rebels is to the effect that everything is working properly as at present.

One reason for the belief in some quarters that the restoration had taken place yesterday is because of the association that unless the restoration took place before the arrival of the first American commissioners, since the arrival of the administration was made public, it could not be made at all, because the sentiment of the United States and the report of Minister Thurston of the provisional government were held to be so strong that the rebels would not dare to resist them to restore Willis's official restoration.

This phase was suggested to the state department today, and the reply was received that it made no difference, the restoration would come as it was used to say that the United States would not sustain the provisional government, but was determined to use what had been done by the revolutionaries, the public would immediately accept the new government, and the provisional government would fall and the Americans leave to take advantage of the amnesty which Minister Willis would issue the agents should grant upon being restored to power.

The American embassy is to advise immediate restoration. At the department there is no real expectation of any important news being received by her, although such a thing is barely possible.

TRAINS MOVING.

Washington, D. C., Nov. 22.—The men are detained, and the man who conducted us valiantly to keep the article off. It is now stated that seventy-seven experienced engineers went out on the regular train this morning. A majority of the men said to be coming from Chicago, Buffalo and Utica, New York, and the rest from the Lehigh and the Susquehanna. I guess it is the same all the C. R. & Q. boys would tell you.

The Lehigh officials sent a train of men to meet those that afternoon. The company have men enough to do the work with if they can operate the yards at Sayre.

X. MINISTER STEVENS

Days are the Hard for Men to Be in

West Somerville, Mass., Nov. 22.—Hon. J. L. Stevens, a senator to Hawaii, lectured on Hawaii and Hawaiian affairs, this evening. The lecture, referred to as the most interesting in the present developments in regard to the Hawaiian question. Before beginning his address he remarked that during fifteen years service as a member of the state legislature, never before had he lost, invariably reduced the political parties in his own constituency, but in question involving the islands he had known the United States and something that in his opinion, particularly, ought to be retained and continued, always with a better right to foreign trade. He firmly refused to consider the Hawaiian question as a partisan question in any sense.
