## SALTING IN WINTER.

Our impression is that salt, and especially white snow, are not equally supplied with salt so regularly in winter as they are in summer, in some cases, to make less use of salt with them. The reason is that the great benefits they get at pasture. Yet the stock are not less eager for it, and probably it is necessary for their health.

It is better to give them salt in winter, but to allow them to salt to mix with the snow. This gives them more salt.
