The oldest monument was a cartouche of Pepi I, a Pharaoh of the sixth dy-nasty of the remote pyramid period and fragments of colossal statues, re-mains of shrines and cartouches of Usertesen III, Rameses II and Osorken II were found. The temple, which had been considered kopelessly lost, was identified in its runs, its area was de-termined and a very large number of most interesting inscriptions were dis-closed. Only one-third of the work of turning the massive blocks of stone in the search for inscriptions was done the remainder being reserved for an-other season's labor. But conclusive evidence was turnished in the friezes discovered by M. Naville of the Egypt-tian origin of the Panathenaic friezes and of other characteristic features of Greek architecture. The previous discovery of the brick treasure vauits of Pithom built for Rameses II by the Israelites had demonstrated the accu racy of that older historian, Moses, and had settled the vexed question of the starting point of the Exodus. The trenching conducted by Mr. Petrie at Tannis had laid bare the ancient city of Zoan, where Joseph was prime minister and where Moses delivered the dwine message to Menephtah, the Pharaoh of the Exodus.
