

Nobody ever considered him insane, but all attributed his actions to moral obliquity. It is said he was hung in effigy at Flint, Mich., with the hearty execrations of the citizens who took part in the ceremony.

Guitteau has received some abusive letters denouncing him as an assassin deserving death from men, but no letter written in friendly tones has come to him. His story that he first conceived the idea of killing the President about six weeks ago seems, so far as can be learned, to be correct, and since that time there is no evidence that he has been in communication with anybody. He pretends to have been moved by what he chooses to call a patriotic impulse to save his party; but selfishness was at the bottom of the deed. He judges all men by himself.

There has been such a demand for the pictures of Guitteau by the police and pictorial papers that arrangements were made yesterday to photograph him. Guitteau was taken out in the rotunda of the jail for the purpose. Several negatives, in different positions, were obtained, Guitteau being anxious that the pictures should represent him to be in a natural and easy position. He was dressed in a dark suit and wore a standing collar, black coat and a black slouch hat.

JACKSONVILLE, 6.—The particulars of a most horrible triple murder have just reached here. Sheriff Meckler, of Hernando County, who lives some miles from the courthouse, having occasion to go there on the 29th ult., left his three children, aged 8, 11 and 14, alone with a negro named King, to whom he had been very kind. The fiend shot and mortally wounded the oldest, then drove the others to the woods and shot the elder dead, and cut the throat of the younger, and left it also for dead. He then returned, robbed the house of what he could carry, and waylaid Mr. Meckler, designing to kill him on his return. A neighbor accompanied Meckler, and the murderer was thwarted. The two wounded children, when found, were able to give an account of the terrible affair, though one, and perhaps both, are now dead. The assassin was captured and confessed the crime. He was hung in the presence and with the approval of 200 citizens, white and colored. He died sullen and unrepentant.

The steamship Tararua was to take them to Melbourne, where they were to be transhipped direct for London. The unfortunate steamer ran into rocks on the south coast of New Zealand and became a total wreck. The two brethren were drowned and 100 others.

I earnestly entreated them not to take such a course, but to no purpose."

They were promising young men, and many mourn their loss under such circumstances.
