NEW SCHOOL BUILDING WANTED.

At the meeting of the board of education, held last evening, the matter of providing additional room for school purposes was discussed, and a motion was carried to the effect that a special meeting of the taxpayers be called for the purpose of voting on the levy for a special tax of 3 1/2 mills each year for two years, to be used for building purposes according to estimates made for repairing the Parker school and for the erection of a new school building.

Electric Plant Appraisers Fail to Agree on Terms of Sale.

Brigham City, Boxelder Co., March 9.—A conjoint conference of the Y. M. C. A. and the Y. W. C. A. of this city, held yesterday, failed to agree on terms of sale of the old electric light plant, owned by the Electric Light company and the city and county of Boxelder.
