As considerable interest is manifested by some parties just now in relation to the question of Mr. Cannon's resignation, we publish the following correct report of that portion of the proceedings relating to Mr. Cannon's examination on that occasion, that the memories of our readers may be refreshed concerning the facts which then and there actually did transpire.

Skipping upwards of a dozen names, our name was then called and we were addressed, the attorney apparently reading from questions as he asked them, though the afterwards denied having written them.

Pros. At. "Are you a citizen of the United States?"

Editor. "Of Deseret Evening News."

Pros. At. "How long have you been a resident of this Territory?"

Editor. "Twenty-four years, though I have not resided continuously in the Territory for that period."

Pros. At. "Are you a member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints?"

Editor. "I am."

Pros. At. "Is not polygamy one of the fundamental doctrines of that Church?"

Editor. "Plurality of wives is a doctrine of the Church."

Pros. At. "Do you believe the revelation which teaches this doctrine to the Church to be from God and binding upon its people?"

Editor. "I do."

Pros. At. "Which do you believe ought to be obeyed, the revelation or the law?"

Editor. "When a case arises in which they come in conflict, then I shall be able to decide."

Pros. At. "Do you not think the revelation superior to law?"

Editor. "I do not think upon this are known through my public utterances."

Pros. At. "Do you believe that a man, in marrying more than one wife, commits adultery?"

Editor. "I do not, if he marries them according to the revelation."

Pros. At. "Do you not believe this to be adultery?"

Editor. "I do not."

When this last reply was made the attorney turned to the Judge and submitted that the Editor be excused from the jury, as it was the intention to try and indict a man for adultery who had more than one wife, and probably other cases of the kind; he would not submit his purpose as a juror. The Court at this juncture was particularly bland, his manner was almost affectionate as he asked the question.

Judge. "Did I understand the gentleman to say that he did not believe it to be adultery for a man to have more than one wife under the revelation referred to?"

Editor. "Your honor understood me correctly."

At this the bland look and accent changed, and the judicial voice was resumed, mingled, however, with a deprecating tone that reminded us of the report that the Judge had once been a preacher. He said that the Court had decided that a man who had been proved to have had more than one wife committed adultery under the law of the Territory, and that decision was law until overruled, though the trial of the man was yet to be pronounced by the Court. The gentleman not agreeing with his decision he did not see how he could be a juror. He then inquired if there were any more questions to be asked. No release being made, the Editor inquired:

"What am I to understand from your honor?"

Judge. "That you are excused."

The prosecuting attorney, apparently sure of his men who remained, made a lumping job of them; after asking them if they were citizens of the United States, he said:

"If there are any of you who believe that a man who has more than one wife does not commit adultery, stand up!" They all sat still, though one apostate squirmed, or he fancied he did.

Again the marshal sallied forth to pick up jurors. He soon returned, and the Attorney asked them:

"Are you citizens of the United States?"

"Yes."

"Are you members of the Mormon church?"

"No."

"You'll do."

The Washington correspondence of the New York Herald of Dec. 30 has the following:

"Associate Justice Strickland, of the United States Court of Utah, called on the President yesterday (Dec. 28) to explain the reasons for his resignation, which is soon to take place. Among them is the insufficiency of salary, which is \$3,000 a year."

Judge Strickland has never yet earned his \$3,000, so far as the proper performance of his legitimate duties is concerned. If a man wants a higher salary, or an official wants a higher salary, let him first demonstrate that he deserves the wished for increase of remuneration by a diligent and faithful performance of his real duties. Then there might be good grounds for complying with the request, but not otherwise. The Utah federal judiciary have much to do before they are entitled to an increase of salary. They are now far too well paid for the work they do, when the nature of their performance of it is carefully considered.

CONGRESS re-assembles to-morrow after its holiday recess. Plenty of work is cut out for it, to serve during the two months remaining of its present session. It will probably take most of its members the rest of the week to get well ready for legislative business, and it may be the beginning of February before they really buckle down to their work in good earnest. Then the numerous bills must be seriously acted upon and either promptly passed or mercifully slaughtered.

EASTERN.

COLUMBUS, O., 5.—About midnight on Saturday the citizens were alarmed by a loud rumbling noise and three detonations that shook the houses, and have been caused by an earthquake.

NEW ORLEANS, 5.—Father Burke received a grand ovation this morning. He inaugurated a two weeks mission at St. Patrick's church.

General Emory has instructions to hold the troops in readiness to preserve the peace. Attorney General Ogden, Louisiana, telegraphed to Attorney General Williams as follows:

"The members of the Legislature returned elected by the State Board recognized by Governor Warmoth before the session of the body and the Mechanics' Institute, are compelled to meet to-morrow under our constitution, in order to preserve their status. Their assembly will be peaceable without arms, and with no purpose of aggression, but simply to organize. The organization provided for by Pinckney has threatened violent interference, from which serious trouble may arise. That organization derives its authority from the attitude of the federal executive and will be controlled by the President. We trust he will of course disavow any interference with the assembly which is now in session, and is rendered necessary by the situation."

JEFFERSON CITY, Mo.—Frank Blair received a number of callers to-day. He is rapidly regaining the use of his right arm.

ST. LOUIS, 5.—Since the wet weather of a week ago many horses with the epistaxis have suffered a relapse, and the fatal cases number thirty daily.

PLACERVILLE, 5.—The new code closed the front doors to all the saloons here to-day. The Marshal will have to close the back ones, or, everything goes.

YREKA, 5.—Dr. Skene and two others arrived from Fairchild's camp, this evening. They report the military lying quietly in camp, awaiting the arrival of the military from Vancouver.

Captain Jack's band continues to steal large numbers of cattle principally from the citizens. Ball Brothers think their entire band of horses have been captured as none are to be seen where they usually ran in the neighborhood of Captain Jack's camp. A fight is expected about the 10th inst.

VALLEJO, 5.—T. J. Johnson, formerly captain of this county, was found dead in his chair. His death is believed to have been caused by heart disease.

EUROPEAN.

BERLIN.—The Emperor William has decided that General von Roon, who has been appointed President of the Prussian Council of Ministers, to succeed Prince Bismarck, shall also remain Chief Minister of War, and that General von Hammerstein shall cooperate with him in the latter position, in discharge of the duties of that office.

EASTERN DISPATCHES.

CINCINNATI, O., 6.—The town of Carlisle, Ky., on the Maysville and Lexington R.R., was nearly destroyed by fire on Saturday night. The fire broke out in the morning at 11 o'clock, and spread rapidly, destroying F. M. Pease and Co.'s dry goods store, Spencer and Campbell's grocery, John M. Dallas' saddle shop, Thomas Clarke's shoe store, the residence and store of James H. Main, and the street front four buildings occupied as stores and residences were entirely consumed. The flames then caught the residence of H. M. Bett, on the opposite side of the street, burning it and other buildings, as well as residences adjoining. Loss estimated at \$150,000. Very little insurance.

NEW ORLEANS, 5, 10 p.m.—The announcement was made at the fusion headquarters, apparently by authority, that Gen. Emory has received instructions from Washington that the U. S. troops shall only be used to preserve the peace, that any body of citizens styling themselves what they may, have the right to meet peaceably for any purpose not unlawful, and that if any attempt should be made to disperse such assemblies they shall be resisted. When this was announced to the crowd assembled in the St. Charles Hotel Rotunda, several simoniacs ejaculated "Whew! The President has gone back on his friends!"

WASHINGTON.—Private a dispatch received here from New Orleans as to the effect that many leading bankers, property holders, and merchants have called upon Kellogg and urged him, by their confidence in his ability to take position, to relieve the financial condition of Louisiana, and tender him their aid and influence in that direction. An assembly composed of leading bankers is being formed for the purpose of taking a new city consolidation loan, which, if successful, will place the city of New Orleans on a cash basis at once.
