FORTUNA IN THE MARKET WITH ORE

Management Received a Settlement for a Lot of One Hundred Tons.

PIPE ORDERED FOR NEW AIR LINE

Will be Laid to Dalton & Lark Compressor Plant—Four Thousand Feet in Length.

The exchequer of the Fortuna mine of Bingham, where George Bamberger is manager, was replenished during the day at the amount from a 100-ton lot of ore, which was settled for on contracts showing 40.7 lead, 7 ounces in silver and 41 in gold. The Fortuna is rapidly developing into a mine of some prominence in the camp of copper and the management has very good reasons to feel optimistic regarding the future.

In preparation for a more vigorous campaign, soon to be inaugurated, Manager Bamberger has placed an order for 4,000 feet of 3-inch pipe to be used in the construction of the air line through which power will be brought from the Dalton & Lark compressors to operate the machine drills. The pipe was ordered sent direct from the eastern factory and en route.
