

## DOWIE CAUSES ROW IN ZION CITY.

In a Meeting Said Overseers of Voliva Faction Were Thieves And Robbers.

### FREE FIGHT SOON FOLLOWED.

Had to Close First Meeting and Also A Second One That He Called.

Chicago, May 12.—A meeting over which John Alexander Dowie presided at Zion City this afternoon, was broken up by a number of followers of the opposing faction, assisted by several outsiders, and before the crowd dispersed, a free fight occurred. Dowie was addressing the audience, numbering 800, and made the statement that the overseers of the Voliva faction were thieves and robbers. At once a number of those in the audience were on their feet shouting "No, no, you are the robber, why don't you pay your debts?" The disturbance became so violent that a Zion guard was sent to restore order. The guard took hold of an old grey headed man who was the loudest in his demonstrations for Dowie to pay his obligations and this was a signal for the guard and were about to drag him down the aisle, when Gladstone Dowie and Deacon Arrington mounted the platform and called upon the audience not to create a disturbance and to take their seats.

After quiet had been restored, Dowie again attempted to proceed with the meeting, but he was again interrupted by the same general disturbance, and he and his associates finally decided to dismiss the audience.

A riot call was sent to the police station and Captain of Police Walker, with four men hurried to the tabernacle in a wagon. By the time the police arrived most of the audience had left the building. In the midst of the trouble, Bush, the negro attendant of Dowie, rushed upon the platform and declared himself at Dowie's side, while those of the uniformed Zion guards who have taken sides with Dowie formed a line of defense in front of the platform. No attempt at violence, however, was made against Dowie.

Dowie was so weak that he had to be carried from his carriage into the tabernacle by two attendants.

At a later meeting called for Dowie adherents only, but which was invaded by a large number of those who were not of the former meeting, Dowie presided, but he was again interrupted by the same general disturbance. He caused to be read a letter from one of his supporters stating that the writer's wife had passed safely through the crisis of a serious illness this Dowie prayed for her recovery. Dowie compared with the case of Mrs. Cantel, wife of an overseer, who died last Friday without medical attention, while Voliva, and his supporters were offering prayers for her recovery. Dowie declared that he feared that the woman died because she had associated herself with the rebels. There was a storm of hisses and shouts of "silence."

"There is death in store for more of you if this rebellion keeps on," continued Dowie. Again the people sprang

## LOGAN SHOWS FORM FOR TRACK MEET

May Hand Big Surprise to Utah Bunch on Twenty-fifth Of May.

### RECORDS ARE VERY FAST.

Provo Seems to Be Out of It With L. D. S. U. Showing Promise of Taking Third Place.

From now on there is going to be some talk in Utah schools for the annual state track meet. Every school entered has shown its colors and at present it looks as if Provo is out of the running, unless there is rapid improvement in form, and that the L. D. S. U., the Aggies, and the University of Utah will finish in the points, with Aggies leading up as a dangerous dark horse.

Yesterday afternoon the rules for the meet were agreed upon. It was decided that the order of events should be as follows:

120-yard hurdles, trial heats; 100-yard dash, trial heats; 400-yard run; 120-yard hurdles, final heat; mile, trial heats; 220-yard dash, final heat; 220-yard hurdle, trial heats; 220-yard dash, trial heats; 800-yard run; 120-yard hurdle, final heat; 220-yard dash, final heat; shot put; pole vault; discus throw; hammer throw; broad jump; and relay.

There will be three trial heats in the 100 and 220-yard dashes and in the two hurdles races. The winner of each heat will qualify for the finals. The discus throw will be merely an exhibition event and will not be counted in the final score.

**ADAMS NOT IN.**

The eligibility rules were decided upon to the effect that no man will be allowed to enter who is not carrying 10 hours of work successfully, and who was not registered at the logging of the present semester. This cuts out Adams, who registered late, from the L. D. U. squad, and he will not be in the final places, through carelessness in study.
