New York, Aug. 7 .- Traffic managers representing a large number of important manufacturing and jobbing concerns controlling annually freight shipments aggregating millions of tons, after several meetings here, issued the following statement regarding their

following statement regarding their discussions: "Matters pertaining to interstate com-merce law and rulings of the commis-sion as affecting shippers were dis-cussed. The questions semisidered are of great importance to shippers gen-erally, and after discussion the meet-ing was adjourned to a future date, subject to call. There was a disposi-tion evinced to bring about a closer association of shipping interests with the carriers and to determine what sug-gestions might be offered to better con-ditions and facilitate the handling of traffic."
