Flood, Fire, Cyclone and Casualty.

Flood in the Ohio.

CINCINNATI, 4.—Much anxiety is felt

to-night concerning the condition of

the Ohio River. The flood last February

with all its terror, tended to make

people more apprehensive when heavy

raids came with a full river, which is

the condition to-day. The Ohio River

is full from Pittsburgh to Cairo, and is

rising to night. From Cincinnati down-

ward it is falling slowly; above, it is

rising with the earth saturated with

snow and ice, and the snow not all gone

from the mountains. Thus, a slight

rain will cause another rise. Here it stood

at 49 feet 11 inches till noon, then it fell

half an inch and then began to rise. It

had risen 11 inches from 3 till 9 o'clock.

A heavy rain fell nearly all the after-

noon, growing heavier at night. Al-

ready the cellars along the river are

flooded. Some manufacturing estab-

lishments have been compelled to stop.

The break occurred in McLean avenue,

100 feet in length, and was caused by

the embankment of the street. This is

the same place where the break

happened last year, and a number

of persons and property were injured.

No lives were lost this time.

Reports show the rain began in the

west and is moving eastward. The pro-

pect is for a heavy rain all night. All

along the river from here to Pittsburgh,

there is much water in the river, and

there must inevitably be a flood of

dangerous proportions.
