SENATE.

WASHINGTON, 16.—The House

joint resolution to print 800,000

copies of the report of the

commissioner of agriculture for 1877, and

5,000 copies of the colonial charters and

constitution, passed and a

considerable discussion.

At the conclusion of the morning

session the Senate resumed con-

sideration of the bill to repeal the

general financial policy of govern-

ment, and gave notice that he

would hereafter submit to the Senate

were in favor of regulating and re-

stricting the liquor traffic.
