Third South Deal.—A. G. Henniger has sold to the Central Realty company, for \$17,500, 97 feet on Third south street, 3½ rods on Second East street facing north for investment.

Glanders Near Logan.—A band of 15 horses near Logan are reported to have severe cases of glanders, and the state board of health has been notified. Means are being taken to stamp out the disease.

Press Club Banquet.—The annual dinner of the Press club is scheduled for Saturday, March 6. Each member is entitled to issue five invitations, and may nominate more if he desires. Press club banquets are among the most interesting functions of the club during the entire year, and are usually largely attended.

Another Sale to Keith.—R. McMaster has sold to James T. Keith for \$26,300 two and one-half rods by 29 feet in the same building block west of Holy Cross Hospital. This is in addition to the purchase previously recorded, to enable Mr. Keith to open up the proposed new north and south street for building purposes.

Trophy Cup Arrives.—Secretary Elmer of the State Fair association received yesterday afternoon, the 23rd, sweepstakes cups awarded as prizes in the stock department at the last fair. These will be distributed at once. Each cup stands 16 inches high. They are of silver, with ebony pedestal, and are suitably engraved.

Crown Clams Little Child.—Mildred E. Madson, daughter of Charles E. and Eddie Clark Madson, died yesterday in the family residence, 479 Third Avenue. The little child was one year and nine months of age, having been born May 15, 1907. The funeral service is being conducted by the regular clergy, taking the place of volunteer armies, and it is the aim of the general government to have this reserve trained for field service to respond to a call in 24 hours ready for duty in any place where it may be needed. Among those who will speak tonight are the Bishop of the Twentieth ward, and Col. Edward C. G. Plummer commanding the first infantry, Capt. W. C. COMMITTEE HEARS PROTEST. Building of foot viaduct at Harrison Depot Subject of Debate.

When the committee of the city council met last night, representatives of the Oregon Short Line railroad and several citizens, who are protesting against the construction of the foot viaduct where it is being placed, aired their grievances. The citizens declare that when they consented to the closing of the Temple Street, it was upon the understanding that the foot viaduct would be built on the north line of South Temple street running into the new depot. It is being placed 150 feet north of the depot, the citizens declare, and they ask the council to compel the railroad to carry out its original intent.

Attorney Parley L. Williams maintained that the franchise permitted the building of the viaduct where it is now being constructed. He attacked the petition from the west side saying that out of the \$8 million it only 10 per cent on real estate and only 10 per cent on buildings. The entire amount of taxes that these pay totals only \$47,15. Some of them, he said, live out of the district entirely. He said that he was unable to find 28 of the petitioners' names in the directory.

The foot viaduct which is being constructed will cost \$19,500 and will be a fine piece of work. No action was taken by the committee, the council having already ordered the company to carry out its agreement.

The citizens of the west side also objected to granting to the Salt Lake Route a franchise for the electrification of the steam road to Saltair because it would require the franchisee for a double track on an over-head trolley line and telephone line. The double track proposed by the company will run from Second South street on Fourth West street, to the city limits. As the streets are narrow some of the property owners are protesting against the double tracking of the street.

The citizens of the west side presented to the board of public works that the holes in the paved streets in which teams have been mired be repaired as petitioned by the Salt Lake Real Estate association.
