### ENDORSED BY SUTHERLAND.

A dispatch from Washington an-nounces that Senator Sutherland has endersed the request of the Utah & Eastern Copper company for permission to purchase 160 acres of land for smelter purposes on the Shebit Indian reser-vation in Washington county. If it is found the Indian office cannot grant the request without legislation author-izing it to do so, Senator Sutherland will exercise his influence to secure the passage of such legislation.
