

THE STORMS CONTINUE

A Number of Houses Washed from Their Foundations Cattle and Horses Suffered.

UTICA, ILL., DEVASTATED BY A CLOUDBURST.

Your Live Stock is a Terrible Rain Storm Reported from Slight, Nebraska.

A TERRIBLE RAINSTORM Swept Through the Illinois River Valley.

PHOENIX, ILL., June 15.—A terrible rainstorm swept through the Illinois river valley last night, doing great damage to the crops, garden and fences.

In Illinois, across the river from here, a number of houses were washed from their foundations and the people fled in their night attire to the high and dry hills.

At Paducah, seven miles west, the water rushed in the houses to the depth of three feet. Cattle and horses were swept away. The crop for a large distance was utterly ruined.

The only family reported injured in Coopers creek valley, in Fulton county. When the flood rushed down the valley a father named Gray became alarmed, and taking his three boys, aged 12, 10 and 8, he started out to find his wife. He was unable to find her, and the boys were taken to the house, taking refuge on the roof.

When Gray was half way across the valley a dancing fire broke out and partially consumed him. The boys were taken to the house and Gray narrowly escaped. The damage to the valley, bridges, etc., will be very heavy.
