

The works are 100 feet long and 40 wide. Pattered with a ponderous mass of exploded boiler, hurled across and through a solid board which portions of his entire fragment of his limbs clung, his legs were recovered 500 feet away. The others were scattered in all directions. The explosion was so great that windows of buildings nearly a mile distant were blown out. Many people in the house vicinity were thrown to the ground. Tables were overturned, windows demolished and the buildings shaken to their foundations. A large piece of the boiler was thrown hundreds of feet in the air, and falling through an elevator roof, fell away. The dome of the boiler
