ATLANTA, GA., 18.—There are

continued reports of an impending

fight between the whites and negroes

at Ridge Springs, Edgefield

Co., S. C., and a party of armed

whites left here this p.m. to aid

their friends, and others will follow

in case a conflict occurs. At nine

to-night all was quiet, but both

sides are armed, and the

growing fear that a war of races

will event in South Carolina, and

Georgia, on the Savannah river,

will go to the rescue of the whites.
