carefully and surrounded with every available safeguard, is the only logical and rational conclusion.

The definition of the word in law and in common language are about the same. Bouvier defines it as being "a writ of commission, sometimes directed to the sheriff, but most usually to four or more commissioners of the complainant's own nomination, authorizing them to enter upon the real or personal estate of the defendant, and to take the rents, issues and profits into their own hands, and keep possession of, or pay the same, as the Court shall order and direct, until the party who is in contempt shall do that which he is enjoined to do." But this is not to be construed as a recommendation or support of the proposition that in every case wherein a supposed contempt is committed, this is to be the remedy even as a last resort; for the author, being a Frenchman, bases the most of his definitions and conclusions upon the French practice, which is so widely in accordance with the Code Napoleon that it requires the presence of a great and urgent extremity to justify a plaintiff in making use of it. For instance, a bond must be executed, in such sum as the Court may determine, in all cases simple to cover any possible or consequential damages which the defendant may sustain, and by which he may be made whole, should the plaintiff also agree not to remove the property sequestered out of the jurisdiction of the Court, and the officer in charge is required to see that no other use or disposition is made of the property than such as is ordered by the Court—all of which tends to show that, so far from being a means of ready remedy, sequestration is a very remote remedy, and should never be resorted to or allowed, except ample preparation be made for such full and prompt reparation as its abuse may demand.

Having reference to the recent order of sequestration issued by Judge Schaeffer against the property of President Young, wherein his Honor adjudged that an officer, without giving bonds, should seize and sell the property of the defendant to satisfy a previous rule of court, we are decidedly of the opinion that, to put it in the mildest form, a glaring error has been made, and that many of the recognized rules pertaining to this equitable remedy have been palpably ignored. If the Court found itself in such a position in the case referred to as required the exercise of this extraordinary measure, the same equity which authorizes its use prescribes the manner in which it shall be executed. A writ of sequestration "does not change title or create any lien upon the property and yet Judge Schaeffer orders it sold, the purpose in this case being to satisfy a previous rule of court, and to put the defendant in possession of the property until the rule is satisfied, and all parties are to be judicially dealt with. In President Young's case, however, there is no such provision made; nothing that is settled upon in advance, and the property is to be sold, and the proceeds are to be paid to the plaintiff, and the defendant is to be put in possession of the property until the rule is satisfied, and all parties are to be judicially dealt with.

Michael Schaeffer, Judge of said Court: The undersigned citizens of the United States, and entitled to vote in all elections in the Territory of Utah, respectfully represent that the 7th day of November, 1876, the regular election for delegate to Congress of the United States takes place in the Territory of Utah, and that the city of Salt Lake, in Salt Lake County, of said Territory, contains more than 20,000 inhabitants as your petitioners are informed and believe; that the undersigned desire to have said election in the various precincts of said city, guarded and scrutinized as provided for by the act of Congress, to the end that the same may be fairly and legally conducted and the result thereof fairly obtained.

Wherefore we ask your honor to appoint for each precinct, to wit, the 1st, 2d, 3d, 4th and 5th precincts of said city, supervisors of election, to see that the rules and laws governing said election are properly observed and applicable to each precinct.

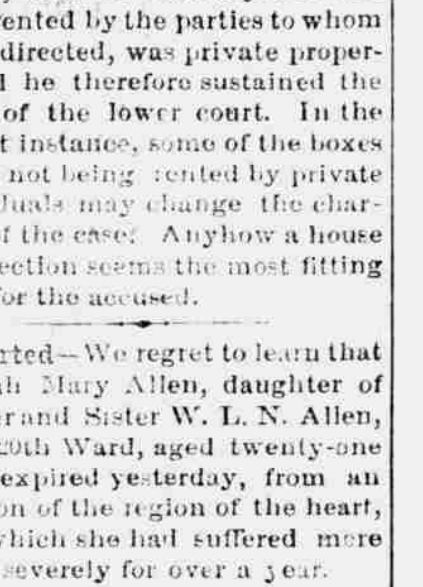
