Death of Mother Praxides.—Mother M. Praxides Sister Superior of St. Mary's Convent in this city from 1855 to 1859, died recently at the mother home of the Holy Cross Order, Notre Dame, aged 72.

Sermon By Rabbi Freedman.—Rabbi Freedman will speak this evening, in the Jewish temple, on "Removal of the Spiritual Leaven," being a Passover discourse. The conclusion of the feast of the Passover will be held Sunday evening when the Rabbi is to speak on "The Jewish Conception of the Messiah."

Tom and Jake Raised.—Mayor Bradford approved the ordinance passed granting the Salt Lake & Los Angeles railway franchise over the streets of Salt Lake City yesterday afternoon. He also approved the ordinance raising the salary of Thomas Hobday from \$1,500 to \$1,800 a year and Jake T. Raleigh, superintendent of streets was given a similar raise by the same ordinance.

Salt Lake Mail Lost.—Postmaster A. L. Thomas has inquiries regarding packages of registered mail said to be overdue, and thought to have been on the Union Pacific train which was wrecked near Castle Rock March 31st. According to records, all the packages on the train were burned it will be difficult for these authorities to trace all the packages, though four of those lost are known to have been on the train.

ROBES FOR NEW BISHOP.

In the event of the elevation of a priest of the church to the bishopric, as in the case of the dean of St. Mark's recently elected bishop of western Colorado, it is customary for the women of the parish to furnish robes. Accordingly the Cathedral guild has taken this matter in charge. Two sets of robes are already made. The first pair presented over by the deacon consisted upon furnishing one set, the second set the traveling robes with purple-enclosed and purple velvet skull cap, will be furnished by this parish. Both sets have been ordered from London. These robes will be a gift from the parish to the bishop-elect, not from the guild, only as it is composed of members of the parish, the organization of the guild simply superintending the matter.

UNIVERSITY NEWS

Today was senior day at the University of Utah and the occasion was celebrated very pleasantly and impressively. In accordance with previous arrangements the seniors met on the library steps promptly at 11:30. From there they marched round the circle to the Museum building, the engineers from the physical building and the arts from the art building, all going about in a grand procession, the students in double file, marching to the assembly hall.

After reading the communication, a general discussion followed. The efficiency of the inspectors who watched the work put in was not questioned. Neither was the action of the city engineer allowing the contractor to violate his agreement by putting in cast iron shoes instead of malleable shoes.
