Record at the local office of the weather bureau for the 24 hours ending at 6 a. m. today:

Barometer reading at 6 a. m., 29.99 inches. Temperature at 6 a. m., 28 degrees; maximum, 42; minimum, 25; mean, 34, which is 3 degrees below normal.

The barometer is highest over the upper Mississippi valley and the northern plateau region; and lowest over the southern plateau, west Gulf states and the S. W. territories.

Light precipitation occurred over portions of Missouri, Kansas, Nebraska, Minnesota, North Dakota, V. I. and the central Canadian provinces. It was snowing this morning at St. Louis, Mo., and raining at Victoria, V. I.

The temperature changes were slight and unimportant as a rule. Zero temperature was reported in Manitoba.
