

## RAPID GROWTH IN UTAH'S WEALTH

Increase Over Last Year is Nearly  
Seven Million Dollars.

### ACCORDING TO STATE BOARD

Net Proceeds of the Mines of the  
State Are \$3,128,820—Increase in  
Railroad Values is \$1,376,104.

During the past year Utah has grown in wealth to the amount of \$6,731,552, according to the figures published by Secretary Thomas of the state board of equalization. The county assessments as made by the county assessors are included in these figures, but they have not as yet been equalized. The equalization will change the total, but as it stands now the increase in revenues for state purposes will be \$5,885,42, if the \$ mill rate of taxation remains.

The assessments levied by the county assessors amount to \$94,155,23, and the assessments levied by the state board of equalization aggregates \$15,202,970. This tax was levied on railroads, telegraph and telephone companies, mines and car companies, making the total assessed valuation of the state \$112,820,533. The total for 1900 was \$105,629,941.

All the railroads received an increase of assessments save one and that was the Sanpete Valley road. That road is rated at \$149,533, a cutting off from last year of \$2,445. The assessments of the Rio Grande Western have been raised \$709,085, the Oregon Short Line, \$321,925, the Central Pacific \$148,949, and the Union Pacific \$58,053. The assessments on the street railroads of the state are raised \$20,525.

The increase in the value of the mines of the state amounts to \$3,128,820, while the increase last year was \$2,373,225. The silver king is in the lead with \$1,000,000, and the Daly-West second, with \$450,000. The Highland Boy comes next with \$304,325, the Centennial-Eureka with \$298,825, and the Mammoth with \$230,447.

There is a uniform increase in the assessments made by the board of equalization the increase in railroad values is highest, being \$1,376,104.
