

Weather Forecast for July.

The chief of the weather bureau predicts the following data, computed from the series of observations for the month of July at Salt Lake City, for a period of twenty years.

It is believed that the July rain will be about the same as the average, or a little more, as the season is not yet started, and the weather is not yet settled. The average rainfall for the month of July is 1.50 inches. The average temperature for the month of July is 65 degrees. The average number of rainy days for the month of July is 12. The average number of sunny days for the month of July is 18.
