

HE CITY ELECTION.

Republican General Ticket With Reduced Majorities.

THE COUNCIL IS RIGHT TO SLAVE.

One Precinct Solid Democratic, the Other Four Two Republicans From Each.

The result of yesterday's election in Salt Lake City was the election of the Republican general ticket by a considerable reduced majority from that by which the party carried the city in the Territorial election in 1894. In the First, Second, Fourth and Fifth precincts the Republicans elect two candidates each, and the Democrats one, and in the Third the Democrats elect three, thus leaving the City Council eight Republicans and seven Democrats. In the First, Lawrence, H. was beaten by Newell, D. Weiler, D. also being ahead of Lawrence, but behind the others; in the Second the labor unions and railway fight was directed toward Cheesman, H. and as a result Allen, D. was elected; in the Fourth, Romney, H. and Stewart, H. were elected over Patton, D. and W. P. Jennings, D.; their majorities being 10 and 2 respectively; in the Fifth, Mulvey, D. beat Cheesman, H. by 11 votes. The city elects its officers as follows:

Mayor, James H. Mulvey; H. recorder, David S. Emery; H. treasurer, John L. May; H. police justice, D. H. Weiler; H. first precinct councilmen, J. E. Weimer, H. George Buckley, H. E. P. Newell, D.; second precinct councilmen, E. H. Callahan, R. E. M. Le Preston, R. John Allen, D.; third precinct councilmen, Joseph M. Watson, D. R. P. Martin, D. H. J. Hayward, H.; fourth precinct councilmen, Geo. Ramsey, H. R. J. J. Stewart, H. W. H. Dale, D.; fifth precinct councilmen, W. P. Mulvey, H. Chris Dahl, R. M. E. Mulvey, H.

The highest Republican vote on the general ticket was for Emery, 3,974; for Cheesman, 3,804; for Patton, 3,704; for Weiler, 3,604; for Newell, 3,504; for Mulvey, 3,404; for Jennings, 3,304; for Stewart, 3,204; for Callahan, 3,104; for Watson, 3,004; for Martin, 2,904; for Hayward, 2,804; for Ramsey, 2,704; for Dale, 2,604; for Dahl, 2,504; for Mulvey, 2,404.
