OBITUARY.

John B.Kelly departed this life July 20,1883. He was born in Douglas, Isle of Man, in 1823. Rarly in life he became convinced of the ruth of the Goepel, and was full of enthusiasm for its power, and to extend it. He first heard it when a boy from the line of Precident John Taylor, in 1840, but his native bashfulness prevented him from embracing it as soon as convinced. At times when meetings were held in private houses for testimony, he would noiselessly creep under the window and listen to the testimonies like an eavesdroper. Despite the opposition of his father's family, and the snears and jokes of his fellow-apprentices he embraced the Gospel in the year 1841, and ever afterwards enjoyed its spirit and work-ed for its propagation. He was the only person among all his relations that joined the Church. He was well known in the Island for his faithfulness and zeal. His first ordination was that of a Deacon, anjoined that he bonored; then he was ordained to the office of a Priest, which he nobit carned; and then afts a course of faithful labor, was ordained to the office of an Elder. He was successful as a preacher, bore a powerful testimony always, and brought many into the Church. He preached in many of the towns and villages of the Isle of Man, and will be long remmbered for his genial and kind course among all and everywhere. He was appointed Presiding Elder of the Douglas branch of the Church and afterwards President of the Course none for all that needed assistance among his brethren, and his course endeared him to all the Saints. Though he suffered in his business relations as a bookbinder, yet he was tree to his convictions, and won the respect of all who entrusted work to his care. In his profession he was known to be accomplished, and merchants and husiness men employing him once, always patronized him afterwards, because of his ability and honesty.

In 1853 he left Mona's Isle and arrived in Utab. For many years he was foreman of the book hindsry in connection with the Nexus office. During his residen
