Resolution in Relation to Ornamenting the Streets.

Be it resolved, by the City Council of Salt Lake City, that all owners residing on opposite blocks on any of the streets of said city, that are eight rods wide or more, be and they are hereby granted the privilege of ornamenting said streets opposite their premises by occupying twenty-four feet of the centre thereof, with trees, shrubbery, lawns, flowers, etc., and protecting the same; the nature or extent of the aforementioned improvements to be submitted to the Committee on Streets and Alleys for their approval and to be under their direction.


