He holds that no such grant was made by any of the acts of Congress, and asyshe does not find that any for-mal decision has ever been made by the Interior Department, holding that the joint resolution of 1870 embraces a grant of lands between said points, although withdrawals appear to have been ordered upon the filing by the company of its maps. The Commis-sioner says no reasons for such with-drawals have ever been assigned, so far as the records of the land edite dis-close.
