EASTERN.

Shipwreck—A New Secretary
The Interior.

CHICAGO, S.—The Iron Propeller Merchant, which left this morning Wednesday afternoon for Buffalo, having on board a cargo of 500 barrels of corn, and 1,200 barrels of flour, struck a sunken rock off One Reef, about 9 o'clock last night and sunk in nine feet of water. The Merchant is one of the largest vessels in the Anchor Line. It was making her first trip of the season, which accounts possibly the bad management of the vessel, as there is apparently no excuse but that of bad sailing for the accident. The dangers of One Reef have been pointed out by government authorities and engineers, and unless they are made unmanageable, such accidents may occur, no other cause can be assigned for the disaster.

A Washington special says it is reported upon what is considered good authority, that a new Secretary of the Interior will be nominated to-morrow, and further that his name has already been mentioned in the special cable heretofore made concerning the appointment.

Moodly and Sankey in Brooklyn.

NEW YORK, S.—Moodly and key began their revival work last night in Brooklyn Rink, which has been crowded from seven to eight thousand. The services were the same general plan as those used in Great Britain.

Decision in the Tweed Case.

In the Supreme Court, yesterday, Judge Davis, Bruce Daniels, holding the term, delivered an opinion to-day on the motion by Tweed's counsel that on each side of the case the court should decide, confirming Judge J. A. Retri's refusal to vacate the ordered arrest, the court should allow the defense to answer the charges like an ordinary accused. If the court gives defendants merely ten days to answer, which will give plaintiffs time to notice the case for trial.

Hanged.

BOSTON, S.—G. W. Pemberton was hanged this morning Charles Street jail, for the murder Mrs. Margaret E. Brigham in Boston on the 22nd of March.

College Deducted.

NASHVILLE, Tenn., S.—The Tennessee Central College in this city was dedicated yesterday, the ceremonies being conducted by Dr. Drunk. The address was delivered by Bishop Bowman, who declared that the college cost \$2,500 and are as determined as ever.
