THE VOTE FOR SENATOR.

McCUNE GAINS FOUR, KING LOSES FIVE,
POWERS GAINS ONE.

15 REPUBLICANS FOR HAMMOND

Democrats Yet Divided—Speaker Roylance Changes to
McCune, and Representatives Hansen and Wheeler
Do Likewise—Cannon's Solid Seven.

Speaker Roylance passed at the joint session today. The chairman of the Friends of Peace, restorer of the joint session, was not, and the voting for Senator was not.

At the call of the first name, Senator Alder nominated, in behalf of the Republicans, Hon. James T. Hammond.

The twenty-third and twenty-fourth ballots resulted as follows:

Cannon, 7; King, 11; McCune, 16; Powers, 2; Jones, T.; Hammond, 15; Representatives Hansen, Wheeler, and Horne, and Speaker Roylance voted for McCune.

President Neuberger called the Senate to order at 12 m. After all roll, prayer, and the reading of the journal of the previous day, the Senate adjourned to meet with the House in joint session.

The House of Representatives met at twelve o'clock this afternoon in joint session with the Senate in the chamber of the House of Representatives. Considerable work has been referred to the various committees, who have been hard at work all day. Report after report has come in from the work. Likewise sent out from here a report about a mile of the wire going from Manila to Pampanga. The telegraph wires had cut the wires at the entrance to the city.

McGraw was made the Democratic nominee. The headquarters of other candidates have been changed and many are now in. It is to be hoped that either Mr. McGraw will succeed or Mr. Howell will be elected. He is in favor of the former. The legislature is to stand in session to consider the bill of rights. It stands in Republican by a majority of one on joint ballot, and that is what makes the situation still one of doubt.

Three Republican members did not attend the session last night. One of them was prevented by sickness and he is from Scott. If any one of the members is sick or absent from any other cause when the legislature ballots for Senator next Monday, there will be no election.

McGraw is dependent on some such contingency, while his opponent has no such contingency to fall back on.

Meanwhile there is talk of more "suspension," a term that is being applied to bills that have been introduced and bills pending a full hearing of their merits before the committee on elections when there is no time to hear such bills.

While the right has narrowed down to the two party nominees, it is as bitter as at any time during the past two weeks.
