THREE NEW STOCKS LISTED ON BOARD

Tintio Empire is Added to Already Long List on the Mining Exchange.

EIGHTEEN ADDED THIS YEAR.

Camp Bird and Mountain Lake Extension Among New Securities Placed on List.

That mining this year will exceed anything since the boom is heralded by the number of new stocks which are being added to the Salt Lake Stock & Mining exchange. Three new securities were added to the board this morning, thus raising the number that have been listed this year to 18. The stocks were called for the first time today.

The Tintio Empire Mining company which owns the Montreal group in the Tintio district was one of the new stocks to be added. This company was incorporated Feb. 10, 1909, with Benjamin H. Hulbeck, president and I. A. Smoot, secretary and treasurer. The company is capitalized at \$100,000, with shares at 10 cents each.

The Camp Bird Mining company, which was incorporated Nov. 2, 1907, with Alonzo Hillings, president, and Robert Anderson, secretary and treasurer, was also added to the list. The company owns 15 unpatented and un-surveyed mining claims in the American Fork mining district at which 400 acres are now being explored.

The Mountain Lake Extension Mining company, which was incorporated in September, 1907, with a William Knight as president, F. O. Friel, secretary and H. C. Edwards, treasurer.

The property consists of 19 claims in the Little Cottonwood and American Fork mining districts. Fourteen of the claims have been patented and the remaining five have been surveyed.

There is 200 feet of shaft and 800 feet of tunnel, the subject of the property is Louis A. Christink and at present five men are employed. The property is 18 miles from the railroad. The equipment consists of a haulage system, a hoist, a pump, a dynamo, a water engine and six supplies. As yet the company has not struck ore.

The business of the session amounted to \$25,752.79 and the number of shares sold was 48,234.

On the curb market there was plenty of stock but no buyers.

Cedar was offered at 8 cents and 7 cents was bid. Lost Packer, an Idaho mine, was offered at \$2.50.

COPPER IS MUCH HIGHER.

Company Has Enormous Deposits of Lead Which Can be Taken Out At Any Time.

The annual report of the Utah Consolidated Mining company which is to be issued within a few days, will contain some interesting figures on the earnings capacity of the company. It is expected to show earnings larger than the \$1 per share paid in dividends in 1908, although the surplus is not expected to be as large.

The company has a contract with the American Smelting & Refining company for the smelting of ore which has about a year more to run. After the contract expires the company will send its product to the new smelter in Pio Canyon which is being built by the Cole-Ryan crowd.

It is reported that the question of building a tunnel from the mines to Pio canyon is under discussion, and that the Utah Consolidated and Utah Apex properties in a connection with the Mascotte tunnel.

It is known that the company has opened up some rich ore bodies in the property to the northward, and it is being looked for well today as at any time in its history.
