manifested by a number of delegates from invited powers, and a propositin carrying it into effect received the unanimous consent o the conference, with an unimportant reservation by Sweden. With this solitary exception the sentiment of all delegates, monometallists and bimetallists, as formulated in the resolution o adjournment, was that a recess until next spring might be productive of important results; that a final disposition of the question by the conference at this time would be impolitic, and there were reasons to hope for an unlimited understand. ing, and that the time had arrived for governmental action and diplomatic negotiations. It was generally admitted that grave monetary evils exist, that some remedy is urgently needed, and that some of the labo s of the conference, such as its ascertainment of the view of the States, and its collection of materials have been of the utmost importance. It is considered that the willingness expressed by the Bank of England to hold one-fifth of its metallic reserve in silver, provided other nations open their mints to free coinage of that metal, is a tacit admission that a great bi-metallic union would restore silver to its former place and value as international money, the reasons stated in the resolution of adjournment have a high and very important signifi-The conference is regarded here as having attained as great a sau St., New York. measure of success as its best friends ald have hoped for at present. correspondent says: Excellent

The Turkish ambassador at Vienna sent similar information, but the Austrian ambassador here denies the report. Two battalions of Turkish troops have been routed by insurgents near Mecca, and 225 Turks killed.
