"Too much prosperity, or at least too much business. The demand for la-bor and for all classes of the employed

was never so great, and never before did the supply fall so short of the demand. The demand has become so sharp in the railway service that many of the employes have assumed a scornful independence and do not seem to care about the interests of their employers. The necessity of business has compelled us to hire many new men, who are not as competent as the old men. Add to this the fact that they know they will have no difficulty in getting work elsewhere, and it is difficult to get them into good shane and to maintain a proper discipline. The Santa Fe is trying to overcome this tendency to

disregard the company's interests by showing the men that the company has their interests at heart."
