GREAT BRITAIN.
The insurance in Japan.
LONDON, 22.—Despatches from Nagasaki say the insurance is spreading, and the situation is critical; the insurgents are advancing on that place, and at last accounts were so near that the foreign residents were preparing to leave.

FRANCE.
Alsatian Deputies Withdrawn.
PARIS, 22.—The Alsatian deputies have withdrawn from the Reichstag and returned to Strasbourg. Taken by the Carlists—Taken Prisoners.
BAYONNE, 22.—The Carlists have taken the town of Vinaros, in Valencia. The garrison of Vinaros, numbering 200, were taken prisoners by the Carlists.

ITALY.
The Pope Wants the Bishops to Come to Rome Before He Dies.
ROME, 22.—The Papal Bishops have sent a circular letter to all the bishops, asking them to come to Rome, as the Pope wishes to see them before he dies.

SPAIN.
Severe Fighting.
MADRID, 22.—Severe fighting has been going on in Blazco for several days. Gen. Doregarray, with twenty-five thousand insurgents, holds the heights above Somorrostro. The Republicans have taken the first height. Their losses are heavy. The wounded are coming into Santander. The fleet has left that port to attack Portugal, which will be simultaneously assaulted by land. Later, the fleet entered the river on Friday, and it was found that Portugal had been abandoned by the Carlists.
