CITY COUNCIL. Ogden Won't Retrench.—New Chief of Police—Other Municipal Items.

Last night the city council met at 8 o'clock, President Bissell in the chair. The rules of procedure were suspended and the mayor's message to the council was at once taken under consideration.

The committee on public buildings and grounds recommended that Mr. Tuleen be paid for 1250 yards of saltpetre at 15 cents per yard, \$187.50, or just \$40.00 more than it cost for saltpetre in the previous year.

A large batch of petitions from the citizens was read and a long ordinance introduced by Councilman Hill, relating to the registration and restriction of saltpetre, was referred to the committee on laws, with the city attorney advised.

Stinson of last night's session of the city council that about May 20 they had not liquor at wholesale under a city license, but since that time they had been receiving a license on the ground that their store was located within one hundred yards of a church, but across at the side of their place of business were erected fences to sell liquor by taking advantage of the hotel license.
