Middletown, N. Y., 9.—Babcock & Waterous, manufacturers of wool and straw hats, have assigned; liabilities unknown.

FOREIGN.

LONDON, 9.—The police are said to possess a knowledge of what is likely to become the most hideous and stupendous plot of modern times.

It is rumored at the Bow street police court to-day that four arrests have been made in connection with the recent dynamite disclosure.

The Pall Mall Gazette says there are six prisoners now confined at the Bow street station who are concerned in the dynamite conspiracy.

In the Lords, in the case of Clark vs. Bradlaugh, High Chancellor Selbourne declared that Clark as a common informer was unable to sue Bradlaugh for sitting and voting in the Commons without taking the oath of allegiance.

Amburgh who was arrested yesterday near Waterloo Bridge, London, was arraigned at the Bow street police court to-day on the charge of being an accomplice in conspiracy with Norman, Gallagher, Wilson, and remanded until Thursday.

The bill to amend the law in regard to explosives was introduced in the Commons this afternoon by Sir Wm. Harcourt, and read the first time, and taken up in committee of the whole. It passed the committee without being altered.

The Queen is making favorable progress toward recovery. She took a drive as usual yesterday.

Liverpool, 9.—Owing to the receiving of letters containing threats to blow up the postoffice here, great precautions are being taken to prevent carrying out such projects.

Hugh Gladstone, partner in the firm of Mr. Gladstone & Sons, of this city, committed suicide by taking strychnine. Deceased was a cousin of Prime Minister Gladstone.

Thirty additional detectives have been appointed to extra duty here. The fire brigade are notified to be in readiness for any emergency which may arise.

Dublin, 9.—The authorities have information that there are in the city 2,000 Fenians who have no connection with the inner circle.

A farmer named Harte, Crusheen district, concerned in the murder conspiracy for which eight young men were arrested Friday, was captured while attempting to escape to America. His arrest is believed to be for the murder of Justice Herbert at Castle Island.

The grand jury found a true bill for murder against Joseph and Lawrence Hanlon, Wm. Maroney, Patrick Delaney, Jagan and Joseph Mullet.

There were 24 arrests to day in the outskirts of Cork and Limerick, and many important documents seized.

Berlin, 9.—The North German Gazette says that the triple alliance of Italy, Austria and Germany, is regarded as inspired by Bismarck.

Vienna, 9.—In consequence of the success of Booth in King Lear, his engagement is renewed.

Two active socialists were arrested to-day. A socialist manifesto is distributed throughout the city.

Madrid, 9.—The Chamber of Deputies has passed a bill permitting the substitution of affirmation for oath when desired.

Castillo, Rodriguez and 40 other Cuban exiles will be released the coming Monday.

LONDON, 10.—A royal message, giving assent to the bill relating to the possession of explosives was read in Parliament this afternoon.

The Times says there was a practical reason for the haste in which the bill in regard to explosives passed through Parliament yesterday, and explains this by stating that some of the members of the dynamite party are believed to be on steamers now coming from America.

Tracy Gould, American lawyer, applied to-day at Millbank prison for an interview with Gallagher, whom he wishes to defend. Gould's name not being on the roll of English lawyers, the government refused him admission.

The Times, in an editorial, expresses belief that the prisoners arrested Thursday, had arranged a plot to place quantities of nitro-glycerine in various parts of London and explode it simultaneously.

Post: the authorities have seized two cases of explosives in a barge on the Thames. The cases were shipped from Hamburg; consignors and consignees unknown.

Parnell is confined to his house; he will probably not be able to actively participate in politics for some time.

A dispatch from Dublin states that one man who actually participated in the murder of Cavendish and Burke has declined to be defended declaring his intention to plead guilty. He has no hope of escaping conviction.

The French squadron at Hong Kong has sailed for Tonquin.

Parnell is suffering from a carbuncle. He was in the House to-night, but left before the debate on powers' motion began.

Bernard Gallagher, of dynamite notoriety, strongly urges his American citizenship. He sent a letter to the United States minister, praying the good offices of the American government, and solemnly reiterating his innocence.

The police continue vigilant watch upon the railway depots and steamboat landings. It is believed they are well advised from America.

Parnell decides not to leave London. He desires to attend the discussion of the criminal procedure act.

Dublin, 11.—A number of arrests are made in connection with the murder of Lyden, committed ten years ago, and of constable Kavanagh.

There is no relaxation on the part of the authorities and parties in their endeavors to detect and arrest suspicious persons. The police have just come into possession of information that a man has arrived in Dublin who is supposed to be an emissary of the dynamite party, and whose mission is the destruction of property.

The Cold Stream Guards have been placed in buildings adjacent to the Green Street House, where the trials of the Phoenix Park assassins are to take place. The object is to secure the protection of the officers of the court and of the informers who are to testify against the accused.

Limerick, 10.—Higgs, fugitive from Crusheen district, was arrested to-day, charged with conspiracy to murder.

Hamburg, 10.—Dr. Havermann, a young physician of Rostock, is appointed physician to the Queen of Madagascar.

Copenhagen, 10.—In the Socialist Congress a motion approving of the proceedings instituted by the Nihilists and Fenians of Ireland and England was defeated by a very large majority in opposition.

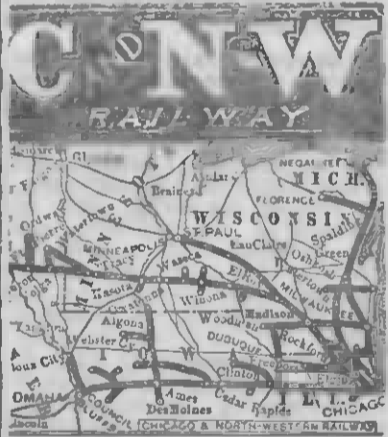
