

# TELEGRAPHIC. ANOTHER CYCLONE.

Tybee Island Visited by a Terrible Calamity Last Night.

## DETAILS OF THE DISASTER.

Gulf Stream Washed Out Roads Damaged and Many Lives Lost.

St. Louis, Aug. 28.—A Report comes from Savannah, Ga., says Tybee Island (that portion of the city lying at the mouth of the Savannah river) tonight was struck by the most terrible cyclone that ever visited this section of country. The journal contains the news of the death of two men Atlantic States two hours ago, now a total loss, with the exception of the doctor's residence. The wharves are gone, the new building plant, which with the city so much money, is in the hands of the city and nine vessels which were awaiting their release came in the city at night and lay on the sand, and no doubt will be total.

It is impossible yet to learn all the details of the disaster. There are many stories about of numerous dead. The property damage on the island is enormous. The storm swept with tremendous fury over a part of the island. Railroads were carried away three hundred feet above the water. The Chatham and houses were practically ruined. The pavilions on the beach were also destroyed. The water is up to the waist. The roads are all the roads are coming to fragments, and some of them have entirely stopped to repair the washouts. Church steeples were demolished, and all other buildings were destroyed. The Tybee river is under water for quite distance and in many places is entirely washed out.

Six victims have now been found.

Wilmington, N.C., Aug. 28.—The remains of Mrs. Harry, a young contractor, who was sailing in Wilmington's port, Alpine, were found in Lake Champion yesterday. Wilmington houses were so damaged that many were left without roof or floor.

FOUR PERSONS KILLED.

New York, Aug. 28.—A special to a morning newspaper from Raleigh, N.C., says: The town of Kinston was struck by a mighty gale. One hundred houses were washed out and many injured.

MANTLE NOT SHUTTED.

A vote was then taken on the right of John B. Allen to a seat from the state of Florida, (the same circumstances exist), and it was decided in the negative by exactly the same vote. No action was taken in this case, from the stand of Washington, D. C., in the same way.

Opposition of the right of James H. Moore to a seat from the state of Mississippi was then carried, the question being on Cockrell's amendment.

While discussing the subject, the House voted to pass out of the committee a bill which was immediately referred to the committee on finance.

Discussion on Cockrell's amendment was resumed, his substitute on the Senate passed—executive committee and soon passed.

**WORLD'S FAIR SCANDAL.**

Charges Against One of the Swords of Justice.
