INDIGNATION IN FINLAND.

Aroused by Breaking Up of Meeting at Helsingfors by Troops.

St. Peterburg, Sept. 14.-The break-ing up by troops yesterday at Hel-singfors of a meeting of 800 delegates from all towns in Finland called for from all towns in Finance called for the purpose of discussing the political situation has aroused great indignation throughout Finland. The meeting was an orderly one and was composed of representatives from all the cities and towns in Finland, many of the best diizens and even women being in attend-

ance, The action of the government in dis-ersing the gathering has found the lissatsifaction feit by the Finnish peoe, which today even went so far as bring forth threats to throw a bomb at the governor general, Prince John Obsiensky. The disbandment of the ast battalion of guards by the Russian authorities has proved to be unpopular, and since the dispersal of the meeting of the delegates yesterday this has been taken up as an additional grievance against Russia.
