HARVEST OF DEATH.

Another Railway Horror Reported to the Welsh Coal.

FATAL COLLISION OF TWO TRAINS.

A Number of Bodies in the Railcars—Loss of the Accident—Railroads—Trains to the Seats.

CINCINNATI, Sept. 22.—As Kingsbury, Ind., is the Welsh coal city and of Chicago, the second section of a westbound passenger train Detroit to Chicago ran into an eastbound freight on a sliding car interchange, wrecking both engines, coaches, and a coupler. It is reported that ten fatalities were taken on board, Engineers Green and Conductor Custer of the passenger cars being among the dead. The engine of the freight was injured. The conductor was taken by the freight engineer, spending the switch to let the freight out of the way and the rest of the passengers on the westbound train out from under the derailed engine. The accident occurred about seven o'clock yesterday evening. The results have confirmed the fatality and of the movements that immediately followed up on completion of the government's investigation.

Twelve bodies are already taken from the wreck and it is believed there are 18 or 20 more.

Most of the passengers were from the east bound for the Western Fair. Of the dead three are girls and the other passengers. Their names are as follows:
