WESTERN NOTES.

Los Angeles is crowded with eastern visitors.

The Western Union Telegraph Company has extended its wires to Cherry Creek, Colorado, and Piney Creek, White Pine county, Nev., and an office will be opened there soon.

At Visalia Pablo Martinez, has been sentenced to be hanged for killing Charles White last May, by stabbing him with a large bowie knife.

A machine consisting of a set of knives revolving by means of a crank and belt is employed at Virginia, Nev., to clip horses and cats one all over in two hours.

A bee at the Solano Hotel, Berkeley, was so fierce that four hours avoidable was raised on the farm of Nichols, from a seed sown in April last, without a drop of rain or irrigation.

The Gold Hill Miner says an immense number of new buildings have gone up all along the Comstock the present season, and many more are going up. A house is built in a day on the Ditch.

Willard Stridt, who accidentally shot his little son, Oct. 3, never "looked up" afterwards, and died of a broken heart and typhoid fever, Oct. 25, says the Gold Hill Miner.

Daniel Connelly, an insane man, was turned out of San Francisco Home of the Inebriate, by the doctors, and half an hour afterward he cut his throat in the street. A bad wound, but he may recover.

A young man named Brady, at Salt Lake City, Oct. 26, intended influence of liquor to get into fight, got whipped, and attempted to commit suicide, but managed only to singe his hair and scratch his skull.

George Marks, hunting near Nevada Butte, County, was accidentally shot by his companion in the forehead. Dr. Sprout took from the skull bone of Marks over fifty flattened duckshot, and he is likely to recover.

John Linderman, at work in his claims at Mount Oro, near Nevada City, Nev., Oct. 22, was driven against the craggy walls of the bed rock tunnel, by an explosion of foulair, and frightfully mangled. He died next day.

Two men—Van Emerson and Shultz, quarreled over a shooting match at the Buck Head hotel, Sweet House Valley, California, Oct. 25. Emerson stabbed and killed Shirz, and one of Shultz' brothers struck Emerson on the back of the neck, breaking it and causing instant death.

The Hollister Advance says a two and a half years old son of David Lindsay, near the Cerro Benito mines, Oct. 22, fell head first into a pot of boiling water. The mother went into hysterics, the child screamed piercingly for half and hour, then became unconscious and in thirty hours after the accident, expired.

Two saloon keepers, Kennedy and O'Brien, at San Francisco, after shaking dice and drinking together all night, had a bout, throwing bottles and glasses freely at each other. Kennedy finally dropped unconscious. About a half pound of broken glass was extracted from his head. O'Brien was conveyed home bleeding.

Daniel Buckley shot Corn Lee with a shotgun at Tehama, Cal., Oct. 21. She died in about an hour and half. He says he did it in self-defense. "She was one of the most intelligent, well educated and good looking. Time and again, since she has been in this country, has seen her head to say, while four-shots her knife and pistol, 'I have made many a man sick at the stomach.'"

The California new code defines the dimensions for standard heap measures as follows: "The bushel, minnow and a half inches; half bushel, minnow and a half inches; and the peck twelve and a third inches." The measures are to be cylindrical with plane and even bottom, the diameter to be reckoned from outside to outside. The material of the measures may be wood, as far as the outside to outside makes possible. Very precise.

Late San Rafael, Lower California, advises say that rich placer diggings have been discovered twenty-four miles east of that place. The miners had water to feed deep. One man can make from five to twenty dollars a day, trees twenty-five miles in length, more or less, and the price of gold over the entire track. This creates quite an excitement. The people are all leaving San Rafael for the newmines.

A private exhibition of the statical feats of a "Fire King" at San Francisco, Oct. 22, was given at No. 611 Clay street last evening. Red hot bars bent with the hands and feet, red hot castings handled, molten lead and iron eaten, were the performances, and a red hot entertainment.
