FELLOW CITIZENS:-It affords me great pleasure to meet you on the present useful and interesting occasion, full of associations having a bearing upon the

pbuilding and prosperity of our newly estabished Territory.

Many of my fellow citizens can well rememer the circumstances under which the first oil was broken in this Territory, and in this ity, by a hand of Pioneers, with our beloved lovernor at our head, who nine years ago left heir families on the frontiers and wended their vay through a then trackless desert and wilerness to this place, and with an untried soil nd climate, committed the scanty remnants of eed to the earth and asked the God of our athers to bless our labors and give the in-

The same season a larger number of my ellow citizens made Utah their resting place, vho, by the blessing of the Almighty God of acob, kept soul and body together through vant and almost starvation until the succeedng spring, when another crop was put in, which bade fair for a good and plentiful harest, but an army of crickets pitched their amp and made ready for an attack upon our rops. Many stout hearts fainted while the prayers of the people were offered up to the Lord of Hosts that they might be preserved rom the awful starvation that stared them in he face. The cry was heard. A host of imely gulls were mustered and sent forth to levour the crickets, which blackened the earth with their numbers.

Thus were we preserved to witness what we his day behold, which so far exceeds our most anguine anticipation that we are lost in hought when we cast our eyes over the native productions of our isolated mountain home.

The Home Manufactures would reflect honor ipon any State in the Union, and far exceed ny expectation. To say they were equal to hose of any other nation would detract from he real merit due, as it is well understood hat Utah has some of the finest mechanics the world can produce.

The fine specimens of Sole, Upper and Harness Leather, of Cloth, Shawls, Hats. Caps and Muffs, Harness, Saddles, Bridles, Boots, Shoes, Nails, Mechanics' Tools, Carding Machines, Steam Engine, and very many other articles, properly elicited a good degree of interest.

The Agricultural department gave me much satisfaction. The fine specimens of Wheat, Flour, Corn, Barley, Oats, Beans, Squash, Beets, Turnips, and a great variety of other products could not be surpassed.

The Fruits are excellent. The Peaches, Grapes, Apples, &c., are of the finest quality and flavor.

The Ladies' department furnished no inconsiderable amount of curiously wrought needle work and other Home Manufactured articles, which has greatly added to the interest of our Fair. There were specimens of Linen, spun and wove by the ladies of Utah, and we would here urge upon the farmers the necessity of cultivating Flax more extensively; it is a native plant of these mountains and is found growing wild to a great height in our kan-

The Plowing Match came off with considerable spirit and attracted much attention, and we anticipate another year will bring many competitors into the field.

The Show of Stock was rather limited. Some fine Horses, Cattle and Sheep were exhibited; but, for this superior stock-raising country, was far behind what it should be. and which we anticipate another year will far outstrip some other branches.

From my youth I have been intimately connected with agricultural and manufacturing interests and pursuits, and have always been deeply impressed with their great importance and utility.

That great master mind, Jas. Buchanan, of my native State, and others of the United States with whom I have had the honor of an acquaintance, by turning their attention to the encouragement of Agriculture and Manufaeture, have blessed the people beyond their expectations; and we in this Territory, with like pursuits, will truly cause the wilderness to blossom as the rose.

I believe this institution is the nucleus around which will be gathered the means of self independence, for which we are indebted to the suggestions of our worthy Governor and the action of the Legislative Assembly, who at their last sitting appropriated \$1500 to aid in the enterprize; and we feel assured they will be more than satisfied with the result, and at their next sitting will make additional appropriation to give strength and stability to the institution while in its infacy.

To the members of Awarding Committees, and to the Committee of Arrangements, who have acted in the spirit of their appointments, and have attended to their respective duties, I would in behalf of the Board of Directors tender our thanks for the efficiency, promptness and energy displayed throughout their proceedings and management of the exhibition; and hope they will still give their aid and support to the institution; we do not consider our labors finished but only begun.

By the co-operation of the citizens a great and good work can be accomplished in the furtherance of the interests of Agriculture and-Home Manufactures in this Territory.
